



ITA Rate Explanations

2024-2025

Dual Meet:

- One match played between two teams, consisting of 3 doubles matches and 6 singles matches.

Double Dual Meet:

- More than one dual team meet played on the same day.
- Men and women dual team meets played at different times on the same day.

Concurrent Meet:

- Men and women dual meets played at the same time. Concurrent duals may have one referee or one referee and one or two roving umpires.

Individual Tournament:

- Men or women playing as individuals, not using the dual match format. Generally, these happen during the fall.

Team Tournament:

- Tournaments played as team events in the Double Dual or Round-robin format will be billed as Double Dual Meets.

Conference Championships/Playoffs:

- Conference Playoffs played as team events in the Dual or Double Dual format will be billed as Dual/Double Dual Meets.

Cancellations or RIF:

If there is a cancellation or reduction in force (RIF) of the number of officials needed during the last 24 hours before the date of an event, each official affected will receive the "Cancel or RIF Day" rate for his/her position. If the official is en route to the event, full pay will be paid.

Overtime:

The overtime rate (shown on rate sheet) will be paid per hour:

- ITA Dual Meet – after 4 hours
- ITA Concurrent Meet – after 5 hours
- ITA Double Dual Meet – after 8 hours
- ITA Tournament – after 9 hours

Parking:

A parking fee will be added only when free parking is not provided

Meals:

Meals are not required for a single dual met. Lunch is to be provided for a double dual meet and tournaments. Dinner also to be provided for a double dual and tournament if officials work past 6:00. If not provided, a \$20 per meal per official will be charged

ITA Tournament Per Diem:

\$30 if overnight and dinner not provided
